VESSEL SAFETY CHECKS

Fred and I cannot exclaim enough how useful a current vessel safety check decal is! Coming back from Florida, we were sort of traveling with another trawler. Coast Guard slowed down and passed close by to us, evidently spotting our current decal, then immediately hailed down our new trawler friend behind us for a safety inspection. It's so nice to be ignored by the Coast Guard.

It's so smart to be safe. To that end, Olverson's Marina is very lucky to have our own resident USCG Auxiliary-US Power & Sail Squadron inspectors.
